STUDENT TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAM

GENERAL STATEMENT

The policies herein stated are to provide guidelines for the Student Teacher Training Program with a college or university and the Sioux Valley School 5-5.

The opportunity to participate in the student teacher training program is a desirable and valuable experience for a school staff and the students of the participating schools.

New ideas, fresh approaches, and the ability to observe others in action are direct benefits to student teachers and cooperating teachers.

To ensure the success of the teacher training program in the Sioux Valley School District 5-5 certain suggested guiding principles have been listed:

4.01 Classroom instruction is at all times the responsibility of the cooperating teacher and student teacher is at all times directly responsible to the cooperating teacher.

4.02 A cooperating teacher shall have a student teacher for no more than 18 weeks, or 1/2 of the school year for any one class.

4.03 Responsibility for the continuance or discontinuance of training of a particular student teacher shall be that of the Sioux Valley School Administration. A committee of the college supervisor, cooperating teacher, and school principal by majority vote shall decide whether a student teacher should continue teaching, if a question arises as to ability, attitude, or prior training.

4.04 The cooperating teacher is to be in the classroom at all times except such times as giving student unsupervised teaching time. A notice of such unsupervised teaching time should be sent to the principal prior to the unsupervised time.

4.05 All regulations of the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education are to be observed.

4.06 Student Teachers - Reimbursement

Reimbursement for supervision of student teachers and administration of student teachers to be according to contract schedule of the college in charge.
