SIoux VALLEY SENIOR PRIVILEGES GUIDELINES
(Tentative Start Date is 1/22/18)

1. Students must maintain at least a B in every class each quarter except Pre-Calculus, Physics, or dual credit courses where a C must be maintained. Students will lose senior privileges *immediately* as a result of inadequate grades. Senior privileges will be returned to them when the next eligibility list demonstrates the above criteria. **All privileges begin on Mondays.**
2. Grades will be checked on Wednesdays for the following week of senior privileges. The HS office secretary and/or your Senior SAT teachers will have the eligibility list available on Thursday and/or Friday. Failure to check the list and continuing to use senior privileges will result in the consequences listed under number five below.
3. Qualifying seniors leaving study hall/SAT do not have to check in. If students are in fourth hour study hall, they do not have to return to SAT unless there is a mandatory meeting.
4. Seniors may not loiter in the hallways, locker rooms or on school grounds. Students will not be allowed to interrupt any classes while utilizing senior privileges.
5. Students shall be on time for their classes. Consequences for being tardy to class, missing a mandatory SAT/class meeting, or using privileges when you do not qualify (see #2 above):
 - 1st offense = loss of privileges for 5 days
 - 2nd offense = loss of privileges for two weeks (10 school days)
 - 3rd offense = loss of privileges for one month (20 school days)
 - 4th offense = loss of privileges for the remainder of the school year
6. Any excessive or unexcused absences from class or study hall/SAT, as defined in the student handbook, will result in the loss of senior privileges for the remainder of the school year.
7. Absolutely NO use of alcohol, tobacco products or illegal drugs of any kind is permitted. (Failure to abide by ANY rules in the student handbook will result in loss of all senior privileges.)
8. Positive attitude in the classroom and willingness to cooperate with school policies/personnel are a requirement. Teachers may request that a student's senior privileges be suspended for a period of time to be determined by the principal. *A student receiving suspension for any reason will have their senior privileges revoked.*
9. The principal reserves the right to revoke senior privileges for academic or disciplinary reasons at any time including late/missing assignments, disruptive or disrespectful behavior.
10. Students must have parental permission to receive senior privileges and this contract must be signed by both the student and parent/guardian, even if the student is 18 years of age.
